

Timbits Tournament Rules 2019

The BVHS Timbits Christmas in the Valley Tournament will follow the Hockey Calgary Timbits Operations Manual Rules and Regulations for the Jr. and Sr. Timbits age groups.

Game Format

Jr and Sr Timbits- Cross Ice- Teams playing one another play cross ice. The players that aren't playing will have the neutral zone where coaches can play small area games, and or work on skill sets during their break. We will have a variety of on ice resources available for coaches to put out in the neutral zone.

Warm Up: 3 minutes

Games: 54 Minutes (60 Minute Game) 70 Minutes (75 Minute Game)

Games: All games will follow the HC Rules and Regs and be played Cross Ice.

Split Squad: We will have four teams on the ice for each game. For the first half, the team playing on the Rink A Side will play a split squad game playing in both the neutral zone and end zone. At the halfway point (27 minute mark for 60 minute permit or 35 minute mark for 75 minute permit) Rink B will then begin to play a split squad game. If for some reason a team doesn't have enough players to play a split squad game the Head Coaches from each team are responsible to work out a solution that is fair to ensure the middle zone gets used for a drill station and or split squad game.

Dividers: Four dividers will be spread out across the blue lines. Players not taking part in a shift will sit on the dividers. The players benches will not be used for the Timbits Tournament.

Scoring: No Score will be kept. There is no limit to the number of goals a player is permitted to score.

Referees: There will be no referees. Coaches will all be on ice to help facilitate the games and skills area (neutral zone).

Nets: The BVHS Timbits nets will be the official nets for the Timbits Tournament.

Shifts: 2 minutes each.

Face-offs: There will only be one faceoff to start the game. The puck is live on line changes. The on ice coaches will place the puck at centre during line changes.

Goals: After a team scores a goal, they must retreat and tag up at centre ice before resuming to play.

Goalies: Goal sticks are permitted but goalie equipment is not allowed.

Jerseys: The Visiting team is responsible to get a different colored jersey from the registration desk for games where teams are wearing the same colored jerseys.
