



U7 Timbits Tournament Rules 2021



The BVHS U7 Timbits Christmas in the Valley Tournament will follow the Hockey Calgary U7 Timbits Operations Manual Rules and Regulations for the Jr. and Sr. Timbits age groups.

Game Format

Jr. and Sr. Timbits- Cross Ice - Teams playing one another play cross ice. Teams will be split up into two half, and 3 cross ice games will take place simultaneously.

Warm Up: 3 minutes

Games: 54 Minutes (60 Minute Game) 70 Minutes (75 Minute Game)

Games: At the halfway mark teams will rotate clockwise one spot and play another team for the second half of their ice time. Teams will not play against their own teams.

Games: All games will follow the HC Rules and Regs and be played Cross Ice (2 End Zone and Neutral Zone).

Dividers: Four dividers will be spread out across the blue lines. Players not taking part in a shift will sit on the dividers. The players benches will not be used for the Timbits Tournament.

Scoring: No score will be kept. There is no limit to the number of goals a player is permitted to score.

Referees: There will be no referees. Coaches will all be on ice to help facilitate the games and skills area (neutral zone).

Nets: The BVHS Timbits nets will be the official nets for the Timbits Tournament.

Shifts: 2 minutes each.

Face-offs: There will only be one faceoff to start the game. The puck is live on line changes. The on-ice coaches will place the puck at centre during line changes.

Goals: After a team scores a goal, they must retreat and tag up at centre ice before resuming to play.

Goalies: Goal sticks are permitted but goalie equipment is not allowed.

Jerseys: The Visiting team is responsible to get a different colored jersey from the registration desk for games where teams are wearing the same-colored jerseys.
